#### **On-line Patient Access**

Did you know by registering with the new Patient Access service you can:-

- Book, cancel or change Doctor appointments .
- Order repeat medication
- View your medical record including medication, immunisations, allergies and test results.

To keep the system secure you'll need to bring along some photo ID (passport or driver's licence) to Reception so that they can give you your unique registration details.

Please note, this service is currently only available to patients aged 16 and over.
