Stay Protected

Flu Vaccine ➡

The flu vaccine is recommended for people at higher risk of getting seriously ill from flu.

If eligible you can get it free via the NHS, our surgery send invitations every year in autumn or early winter or you can get yours via your local pharmacy.

Covid 19 Vaccine ➡

This is now available on request from local participating pharmacies.

RSV, Pneumonia & Shingles Vaccine ➡

Available by invitation. If you think you are eligible but have not been contacted, get in touch.

Eligibility for Free NHS Flu Vaccines

- ➡ Pregnant women
- ➡ All children aged 2-3 years
- ➡ All children in clinical risk groups aged 6 months to 18 years
- ➡ Those aged 18-65 in clinical risk groups
- ➡ Those aged 65 and over
- ➡ Those in long stay residential care homes
- ➡ Main carer for an elderly or disabled person, or those receiving carer's allowance
- ➡ Those in close contact of immunocompromised individuals
- ➡ Frontline health and social care workers can also get a flu vaccine through their employer

What is the NHS App?

The NHS App is owned and run by the NHS. It can be accessed by anyone aged 13 and over registered with an NHS GP surgery in England or Isle of Man.

It doesn't replace existing services. You can still contact your GP surgery in the usual ways.
